A "Time" is one year. Dan. 4:23. In prophecy a day = one year. Ezek. 4: 6. Num. 14:34

Times = 2 years or 720 days = 720 years  
Time = 1 year or 360 days = 360 years  
1/2 Time = 1/2 year or 180 days = 180 years  
1260 years

Papacy is shorn of power, yet exists

The PAPAL GOVERNMENT is the LITTLE HORN:

1. Papacy emerged AFTER the Roman Empire broke up in 476.
2. The pope plotted the plucking up of three Arian horns that opposed it.
3. The papacy is both religious and civil: Pope is both a priest and king.
4. Papacy persecuted saints for 1260 years.
5. Papal Rome changed the times and laws: Substituted Sunday for the 7th day Sabbath. Eliminated the 2nd commandment and split the 10th into two.
